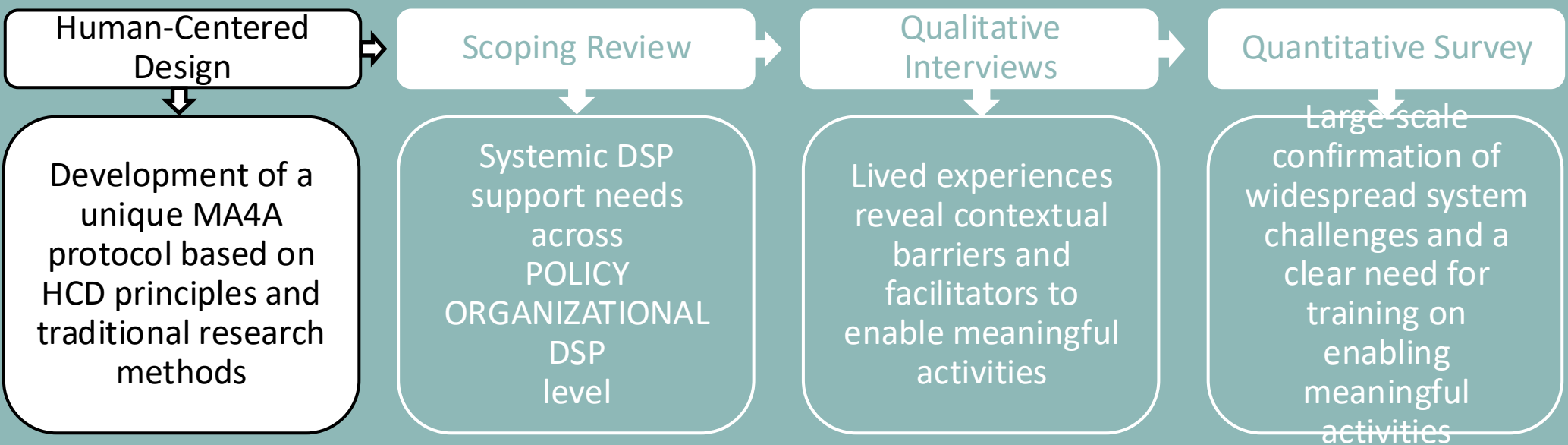
## The story of Erik and Daisy

Some interesting figures

- Draws inspiration from scientific research: 8,3%
- Experience policy as beneficial: 9,2%
- Affinity with the activity they must enable: 94,4%
- Experience the most support of their colleagues: 88,1%
