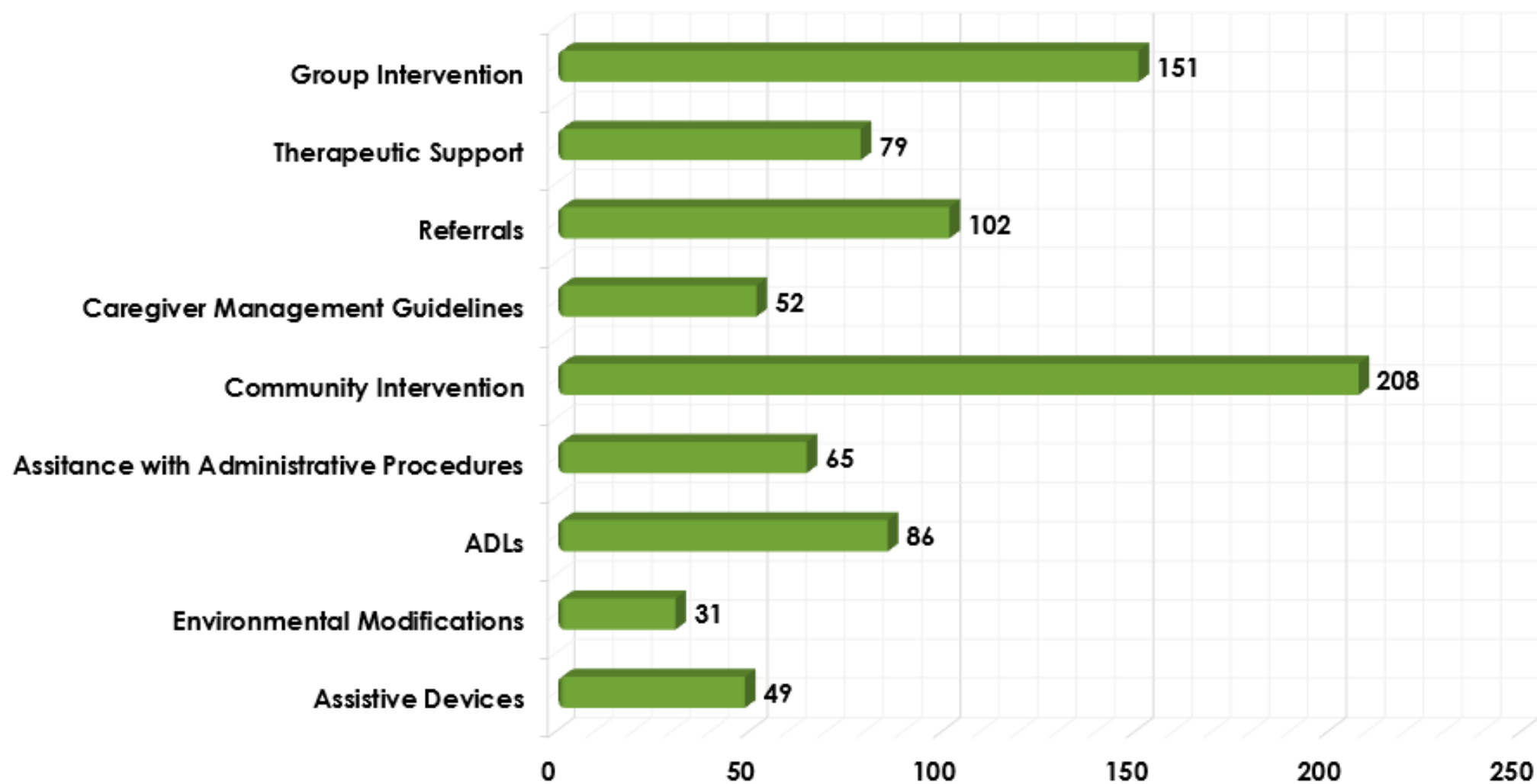


Distribution of People Served by Mode of Contact



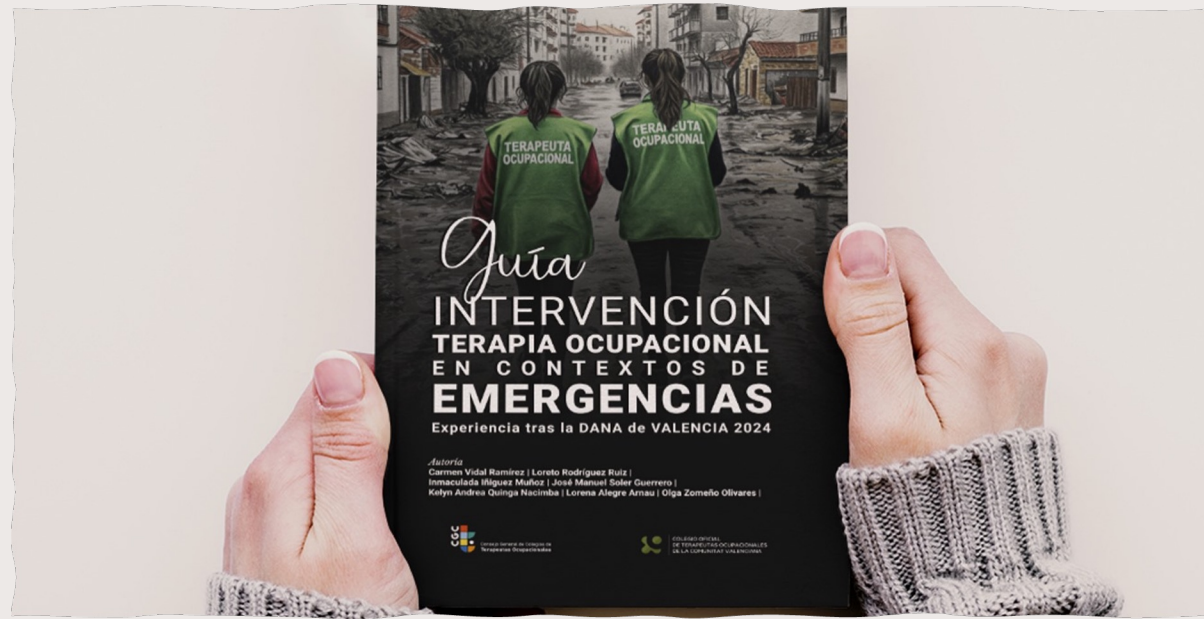
